Chapter 729 Members & Aviation Friends:

Most of you know AirVenture Oshkosh 2022 was an outstanding year and once again broke records in attendance and aircraft! 650,000+ people along with 1,375 vintage, 1,156 homebuilt, 369 warbirds, 137 ultralights, 87 seaplanes, 77 aerobatic aircraft, and 25 rotorcraft registered, made this a banner year. And we're grateful to have our international aviation brethren's back in attendance.

Over 10,000 aircraft attended KOSH and surrounding airports making it quite busy for all aviators and associated personnel. KOSH experienced 18,684 aircraft operations in the 11-day period from July 21-31, which is an average of approximately 121 takeoffs/landings per hour when the airport is open. Next year has promises to be similar, as EAA prepares for their 70th anniversary.

Sadly, we learned on Monday morning the passing of Tom Poberezney, son of EAA founder Paul Poberezney. Tom was EAA 1989-2010 president for and will remembered for several milestone achievements. Undoubtedly, Tom's biggest milestone will be the founding of the EAA Young Eagles program, now with over 2.2 million youth flown since inception in 1992. Because of this -EAA has sparked countless youth to pursue an aviation career/hobby.

A very nice tribute by the T-34 Formation Group was completed on Wednesday, utilizing 16 aircraft in squadron formation completing the "Missing Man Flyby" maneuver. Turning from sorrow to happiness, now is a good time to start planning for AirVenture Oshkosh 2023!

Back here at KBAK...EAA 729 is pleased to announce Kyler Rimer has been approved as 2022 Ray Scholar to obtain his PPL. Previously selected and mentioned, we learned Friday of Kyler's approval by Ray Scholarship Foundation. A senior at Columbus Signature Academy (East High being anchor), Kyler is eyeing flying for the U.S. Marines upon graduation. He will start his flight training immediately with BFC and has already been studying training manuals.

Now three years in a row, EAA 729 has administered this scholarship valued at \$10,000. Congratulations Kyler and look forward to your growth!

Several flying activities are occurring in August and hope you will join at least one event. Here at KBAK, starting on "National Aviation Day" of Friday, August 19 at 5:00pm, Columbus Municipal Airport (KBAK) is partnering with AOPA on "The Layover" fly-in camping event.
